


# **ANY BODY: A COMIC COMPENDIUM OF IMPORTANT FACTS AND FEELINGS ABOUT OUR BODIES**

42	Gender is the way we feel inside about who we are, while sex has more to do with body parts and biology. When a baby is born, most people assume they know the baby's gender based on the appearance of their body and whether they have a male or female genitals. We now understand that gender is more than just two opposites; it is a whole range of feelings and ways of being.
	There may be male, female, masculine, feminine, trans, non-binary, genderqueer, boy, girl, and many other words people use to describe themselves.
	They may identify as non-binary, agender, or genderqueerOthers come to know during puberty or as adults that their feelings about their gender don't match what others assume about them.
	You might not know a person's gender identity when you first meet them. Try using the pronoun "they," which refers to any gender- it's nice not to make assumptions.
43	A trans person might feel that the body they are born with doesn't match who they are. A person born with a vagina who identifies as a boy is a trans boy, and a person born with a penis who identifies as a girl is a trans girl. Sometimes trans people change their names, their appearance, their bodies- it's up to each person to decide how they want to present themselves. 



## Penis

Penises are for peeing, to feel pleasure, or to help make a baby. The tip of the penis, which is very sensitive, is called the glans. At birth this is hidden under a retractable foreskin, but it is exposed in people who have been circumcised. Circumcision is when the foreskin is removed a few weeks after birth. It is fairly common in different cultures for religious and health reasons.


#### Did you know?

Hardly any penises are straight like a ruler. Especially when they are stiff, you can see that most penises bend a bit to the left or to the right.

In the scrotum, which is found behind the penis, are two little balls called testicles. This is where sperm cells are produced.

During sex or masturbation, semen containing sperm can come out of the tip of the penis and provide a great feeling of pleasure. The penis and scrotum can be soft and relaxed or firm and hard, or anywhere in between.

Every penis is different and one of almost four billion versions in the world. None of them look the same.


