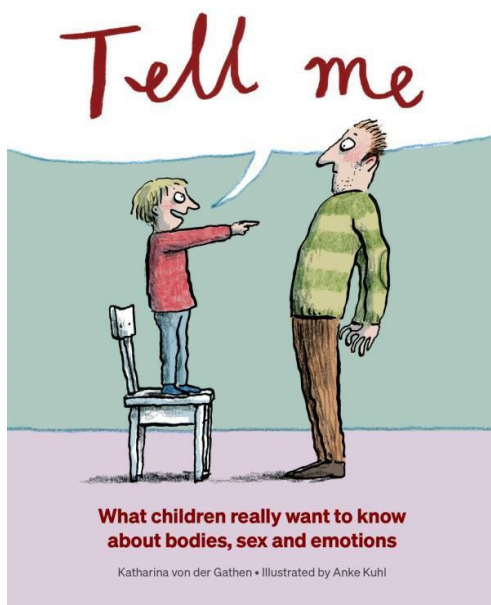

1	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a young, pre-pubescent girl standing nude in front of a full-length mirror. Her nipples, vulva, and buttocks are exposed.</p>
2	<p>The illustration on this page depicts several cartoon penises. The words bellow the image reads: Are there different penises?</p>
3	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a nude young woman shown from behind, bent over with her hands on the floor. The following parts are labeled: VAGINA, INNER LABIA, CLITORIS, BELLYBUTTON, BREASTS, HEEL, BIG TOE, EAR, ELBOW, MONS PUBIS, URETHRA, OUTER LABIA, and ANUS.</p> <p>(Others can be intersex, but that's a different topic.) ...People use the word vagina to mean what you can see between the legs of women and girls, but it's actually a vulva, which has several parts: the outer and inner labia or lips at the front, under a kind of "hood," is the clitoris further back is the urethra exit, where urine comes out of a small hole and behind that is the entrance to the vagina.</p>
4	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a nude man standing with his arms raised. His penis is wrapped around his body. <i>See Figure 1.</i></p> <p>Many penises are pretty small at first glance. But once a penis swells, it can suddenly look quite big.</p>
5	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a nude young girl in a profile view. She is sitting with her knees bent upward. Her left hand is hidden behind her knee. She is looking downward toward her pubic region.</p> <p>Are Girls born with a clitoris? ...The clitoris is a body part whose only purpose is to give feelings of pleasure. ...Just like the tip of a penis, it is very sensitive to touch. Even little babies can feel pleasure when they rub their clitoris.</p>
6	<p>"HI HERB, LONG TIME NO SEE." "ACTUALLY I'M SUSANNE NOW, AT LAST!"</p> <p>How does a man get a vagina if he had a penis? Most people are born with either male or female genitals, but body parts and who a person feels themselves to be are not always the same thing. Sometimes a baby can be born with a penis and they are told they are a boy, but they are actually a girl. They and their parents might only come to realize things are different for them over a period of time. Their "boy" body doesn't feel right and they start to identify as a trans girl. ...They might decide to talk to a doctor about changing their body with artificial hormones. These can stop body changes like growing a beard and start other changes, like forming breasts. Later, some people choose to undergo a complicated operation that can form a vagina from a penis. It is the same for a person born with the parts of a girl who is actually a boy. People who identify as a different gender than the one they are born with are called transgender.</p>

7	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a young man in a posterior view bent over. His hands are resting on his inner thighs and his head is bent downward toward his scrotum.</p> <p>What are the bags behind the penis?</p>
9	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a nude man sitting on the edge of a bed. His is looking at his penis through a magnifying glass.</p> <p>Sperm can come out of the body when someone ejaculates. Ejaculation happens at the most intense sexual stimulation, and then a whitish liquid squirts or dribbles out of the penis (about a teaspoonful).</p>
15	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a nude young pre-pubescent girl and a nude young woman standing next to each other. They are shown in a frontal view with their breasts, nipples, and vulvas exposed. The words under the pre-pubescent girl read: LENA, 14 years. The words under the young woman read: Susie, 11 years.</p>

A young man is walking past the adults fully clothed with his right hand covering his eyes. <i>See Figure 2.</i></p> <p>Why is it embarrassing to see someone elses penis or vagina?</p>
18	<p>"BREASTS...SEX...PENIS...NUDE..."</p> <p>Why do I get a stiff penis when I hear people talk about sex?</p>
19	<p>Everyone who has a penis will experience an ejaculation at some point. If you are sexually excited and the feeling becomes very strong, a whitish, sticky liquid comes out of the stiff penis.</p> <p>...At that moment, for a few seconds, you might have a wonderful feeling of pleasure. This is called an orgasm.</p> <p>An ejaculation can come when you masturbate, or at night when you're asleep and don't even notice it, or while you're having a wonderful sexy dream. When you wake in the morning, your pajama pants might be damp.</p>
26	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a man and an another individual kissing. The other individual has a young girl sitting on their lap.</p> <p>Why do people feel desire?</p> <p>...Adults and teenagers might also feel a desire to have sex.</p> <p>...Some people don't feel sexual desire and that's fine, too.</p>
27	<p>A young child is pointing at a couple pushing a baby stroller shouting, "YOU'VE HAD SEX AT LEAST ONCE!"</p>
28	<p>The illustrations on this page depict several individuals engaged in various types of kissing. The couple on the top-left side of the page depict a man and woman kissing on the lips. Two children on the middle of the page are sticking their tongues out at each other. On the bottom-right side of the image, two men in an embrace, are kissing each other.</p>

31	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a young man with a thought bubble above his head. The thought bubble depicts a nude man lying on a bed beneath a nude woman straddling the man's pelvis. <i>See Figure 3.</i></p> <p>How come it feels so weird to think about sex? ...Others might not want to imagine people they know- like their own parents- having sex.</p>
32	<p>Can children be gay? People may only become aware at puberty whether they are gay or not. Some people know very early on, but others don't realize until they're adults that they love people of their own sex. ...Sexual identity- that is, how you think of your own sexual feelings and who you are attracted to- isn't just about being gay or heterosexual. There is a whole spectrum of different ways to feel and be.</p>
33	<p>What does sex feel like?</p>
34	<p>Can people die having sex?</p>
35	<p>What makes sex fun? ...They kiss and caress one another. Sex is like an adventure. There are unexplored places all over the body, and familiar places to visit again and again. Sometimes one person lets another take the lead, and sometimes they race through together.</p>
36	<p>Can you have sex when you reach puberty?</p>
40	<p>How many words are there for sex? Think about how many you already know. You'll come up with plenty! ...Funny words like bonking or rumpy pumpy.</p>
41	<p>The illustration on this page depicts an ancient soldier pointing at a man holding his toga out to the side exposing his penis. The soldier is saying, "SEXUS".</p> <p>...These days we use the word gender differently, too. It refers to a broader idea than the biological sex a person is born with. Gender refers to a whole spectrum of ways people can feel about and present themselves- trans, female, gender fluid, male, bigender, and more...</p>
42	<p>Who was the first person to have sex? ...We can't answer this question more precisely because we don't know exactly who the first humans were, but they lived on the earth more than three million years ago. Humans evolved from animals.</p>
43	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a nude man and woman sitting up on a bed. The woman's breasts and nipples are exposed.</p>
44	<p>The illustration on this page depicts two triceratops mating.</p> <p>All mammals do it the same way: the male climbs onto the female and pushes his penis into her vagina.</p>
45	<p>Can animals be gay? Animal researchers have observed that in many species, males mate with males or females with females.</p>
46	<p>Do you have to be naked to have sex? No! No one has to do anything during sex.</p>

47	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a young girl playing with a nude male doll and a nude female doll. The young girl placed the pelvises of the two dolls together with their legs scissoring each other. <i>See Figure 3.</i></p> <p>How do a man and a woman have sex? ...It's about people wanting to be very close and touch each other so their bodies feel all tingly. If a woman and a man both want to have sexual intercourse, once the man's penis gets very hard and the woman's vagina gets wet, they slide the penis into the vagina. Each movement back and forth makes the tingling sensations stronger until it suddenly comes to a quivery climax, called an orgasm. It feels a bit like being on a swing, getting higher and higher, until at the highest point there's a feeling of happy release.</p>
48	<p>How do you have sex if the penis is too big and the vagina too small? ...Besides, the vagina automatically gets moist when a woman is in the mood for sex. This makes it easier for even a large penis to slide into it.</p>
50	<p>What is homosexual? ...So homosexual means feeling sexual with someone of the same sex. Gay and queer are more commonly used words, and gay women are also called lesbians.</p>
51	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a group of individuals standing behind a rainbow-colored flag with LGBTQ+ written on it. One individual is holding a sign reading: BE FREE! Another man is holding a sign reading: DIVERSITY.</p> <p>What does LGBT mean? People are different and people love differently. ...L stands for "lesbian": women who love women. G stands for "gay": anyone who loves people of the same sex as they are, especially men who love men. B stands for "bisexual": women who love women and men, or men who love men and women. T stands for "trans": women who are seen as boys at birth because of their physical characteristics or men who were seen as girls at birth because of their physical characteristics. Q stands for "queer": an umbrella term that describes many sexual identities other than heterosexuality.</p>
53	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a nude woman lying on a bed underneath a nude man. The woman's legs are spread open as the man's pelvis is pressed into the woman's pelvis. <i>See Figure 4.</i></p> <p>Who is on top during sex? ...Some people take turns, others always do the same thing. And there are other positions, too. Not just above and below, but front and behind or left and right, standing, sitting, lying down- people work out together what they want to do and how.</p>
54	<p>The illustration on this page depicts a young girl playing with two nude dolls lying next to each other.</p> <p>How do gay people have sex?</p>

	...The people having sex touch each other in sensitive areas and give each other pleasure to bring about the thrilling sensation called orgasm.
56	You're often naked, sometimes sweaty, sometimes moaning with pleasure, and you're not always completely in control.
57	The illustration on this page depicts a bride and groom. A young girl is standing next to them saying, "YOU GUYS, NOW YOU CAN FINALLY HAVE SEX!"
58	The illustration on this page depicts a nude man and woman from the chest upward. The woman is biting and pulling the man's right ear.
59	But sometimes the sperm can reach the egg a different way, such as in a laboratory under a microscope. The fertilized egg is then implanted into the woman's body- this is called in vitro fertilization. Or the sperm cells may be put directly into the woman's body using a kind of syringe. This is called artificial insemination.
60	Who is a sperm donor? This is a person who donates or sells their sperm.
62	External condoms fit over the stiff penis and internal condoms fit inside the vagina. The semen that comes out of the penis during sex is caught in the condom and doesn't go into the other person's body.
63	Why can't young children have sex? ...Some children like to touch their own bodies when they are alone and feel sexual pleasure. This is fine and a good way to get to know your ow body and how and where you like to be touched.
64	Can people have sex underwater? Yes, that's possible. ...In fact, people can have sex anywhere- under the dining-room table, on the beach, on the roof of the garage, in the bathtub, in the car, between the shelves in the basement.
65	Why do people moan and groan during sex? ...For some people sex is such a wonderful and exciting activity that they grown or even scream.
66	What's masturbation? Many people find it exciting and pleasurable to touch sensitive parts of their own body, such as the breasts, penis, clitoris and vulva, stroking them again and again. ...The delicious feeling can grow and become more and more intense until it might peak in a little explosion of happiness called an orgasm. ...In any case, masturbation is something children should do alone. It's good and completely normal to want to get to know your body better.
67	The illustration on this page depicts an older man sitting on a cushion while looking in a magazine with two nude women lying together. One woman is lying on her back with her breasts and nipples exposed while the other woman is lying on her stomach with her head between the other woman's breasts. What is porn?
69	What is a prostitute? A prostitute is a sex worker: someone who is paid to have sex.

70	The illustration on this page depicts a man walking into a store with a sign reading: SEXSHOP What goes on in a sex shop?
73	What is rape? Rape is when a person is forced to have sex against their will.
75	Or she might choose to end the pregnancy with an abortion (a medical procedure).
82	Can gay people have children? ...Some lesbian couples will get sperm from a man they know. Or they can buy sperm. Gay couples might ask a woman to have a child for them.
85	Some babies are intersex- they have sexual parts associated with both males and females. How a person feels inside about their gender isn't known until the person can and wants to tell others.
91	The illustration on this page depicts a pregnant woman lying on a bed with her knees bent giving birth to a baby. The baby's head is shown coming out of the woman's vagina while a woman and a man stand on either side of her.

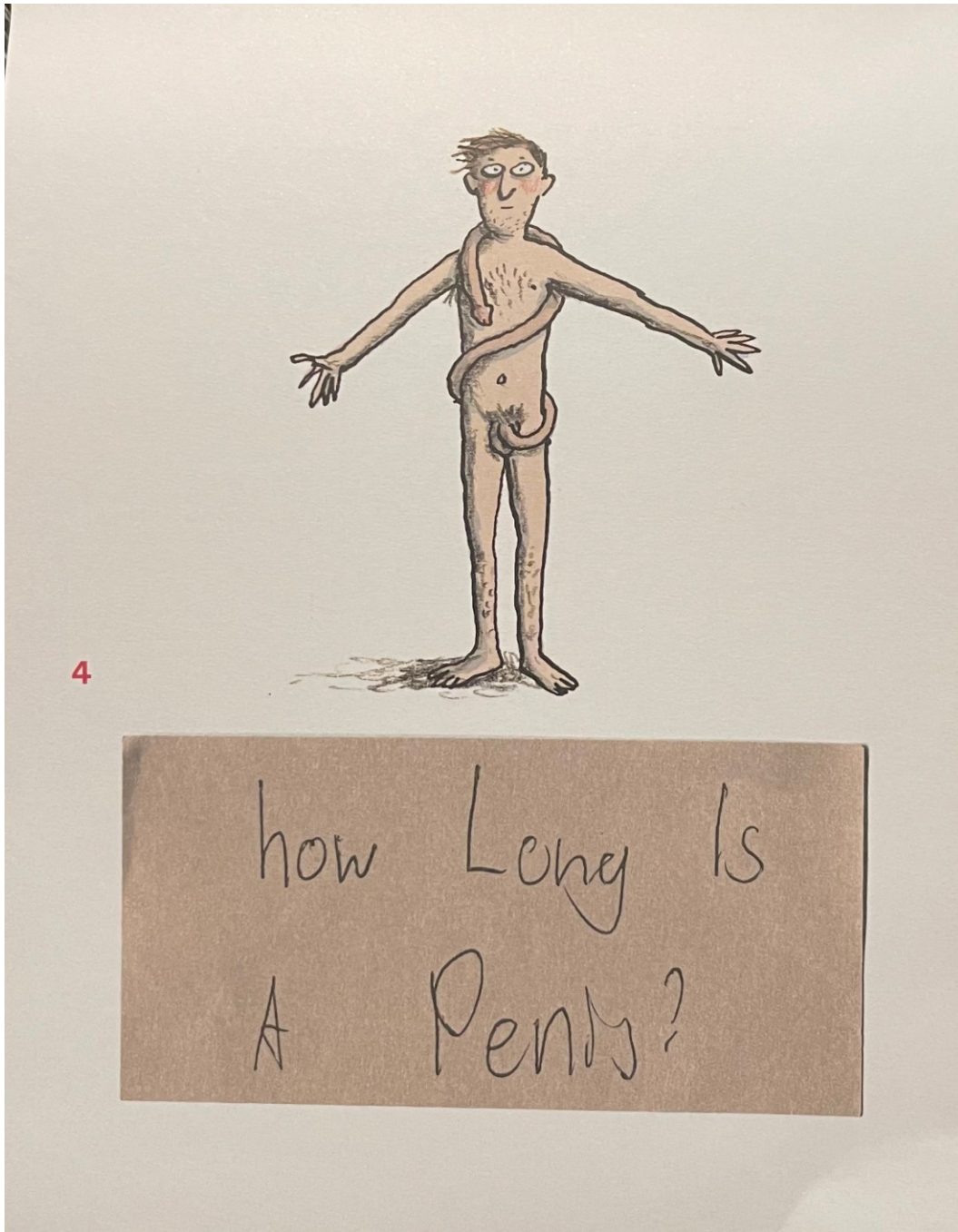

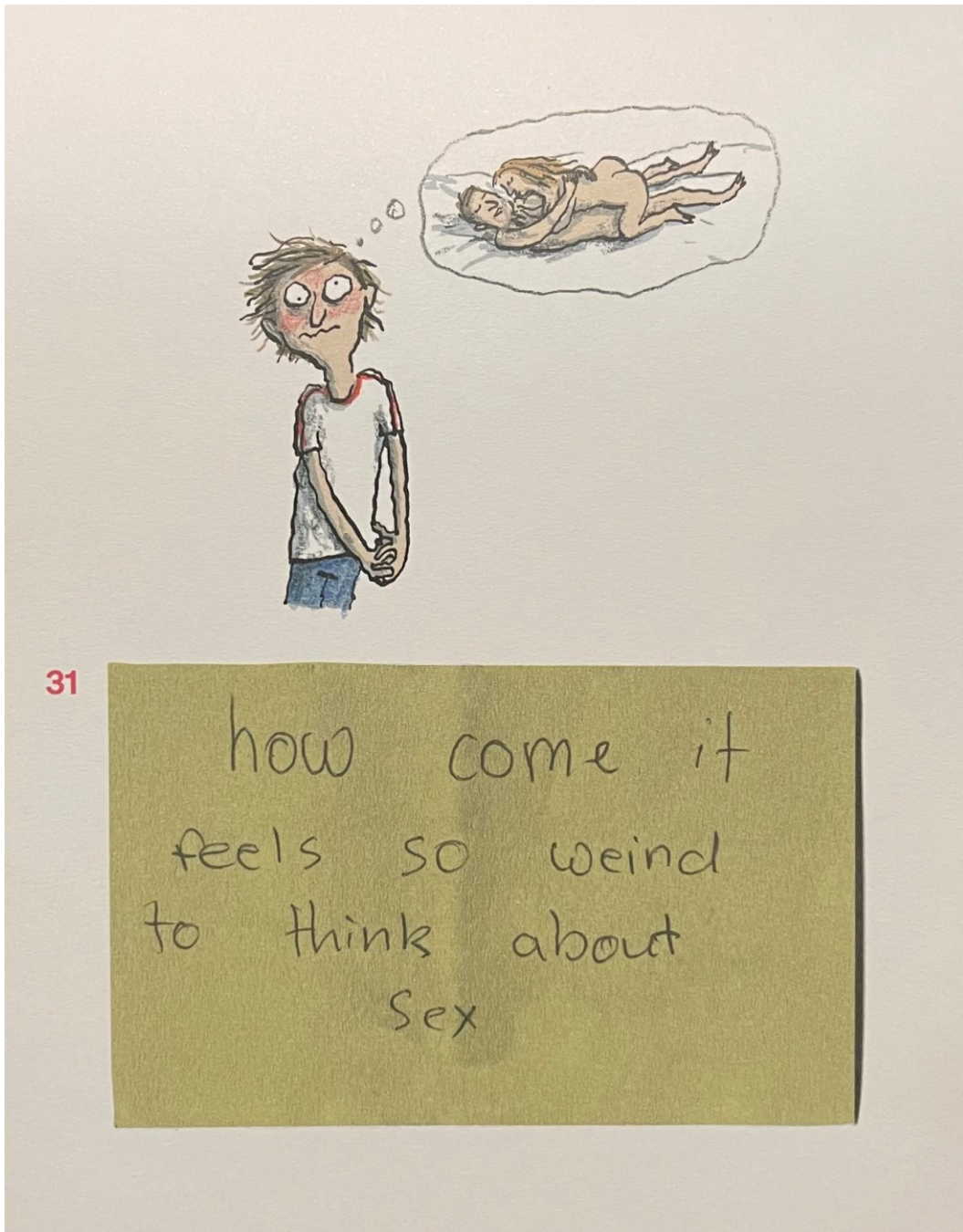

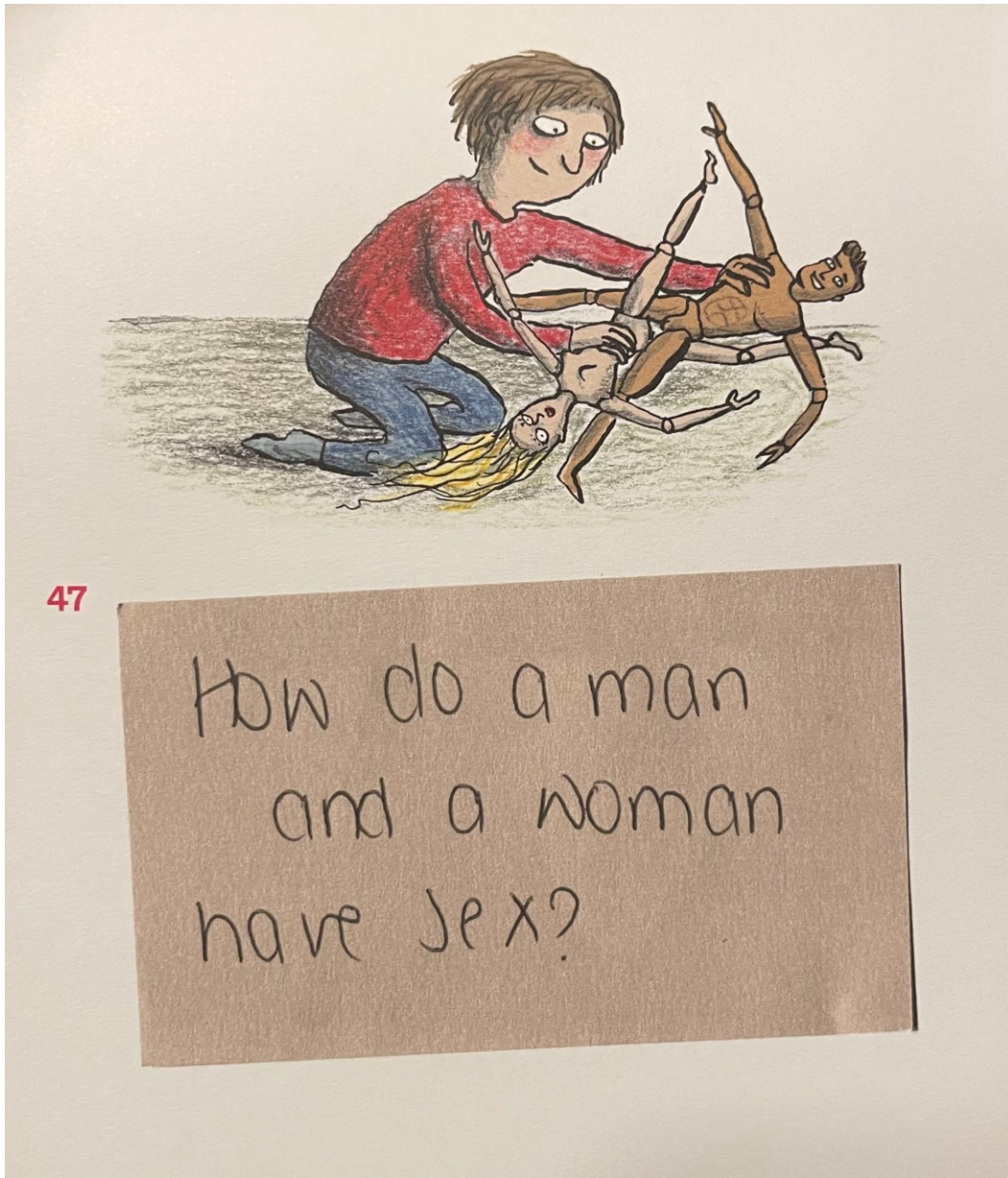

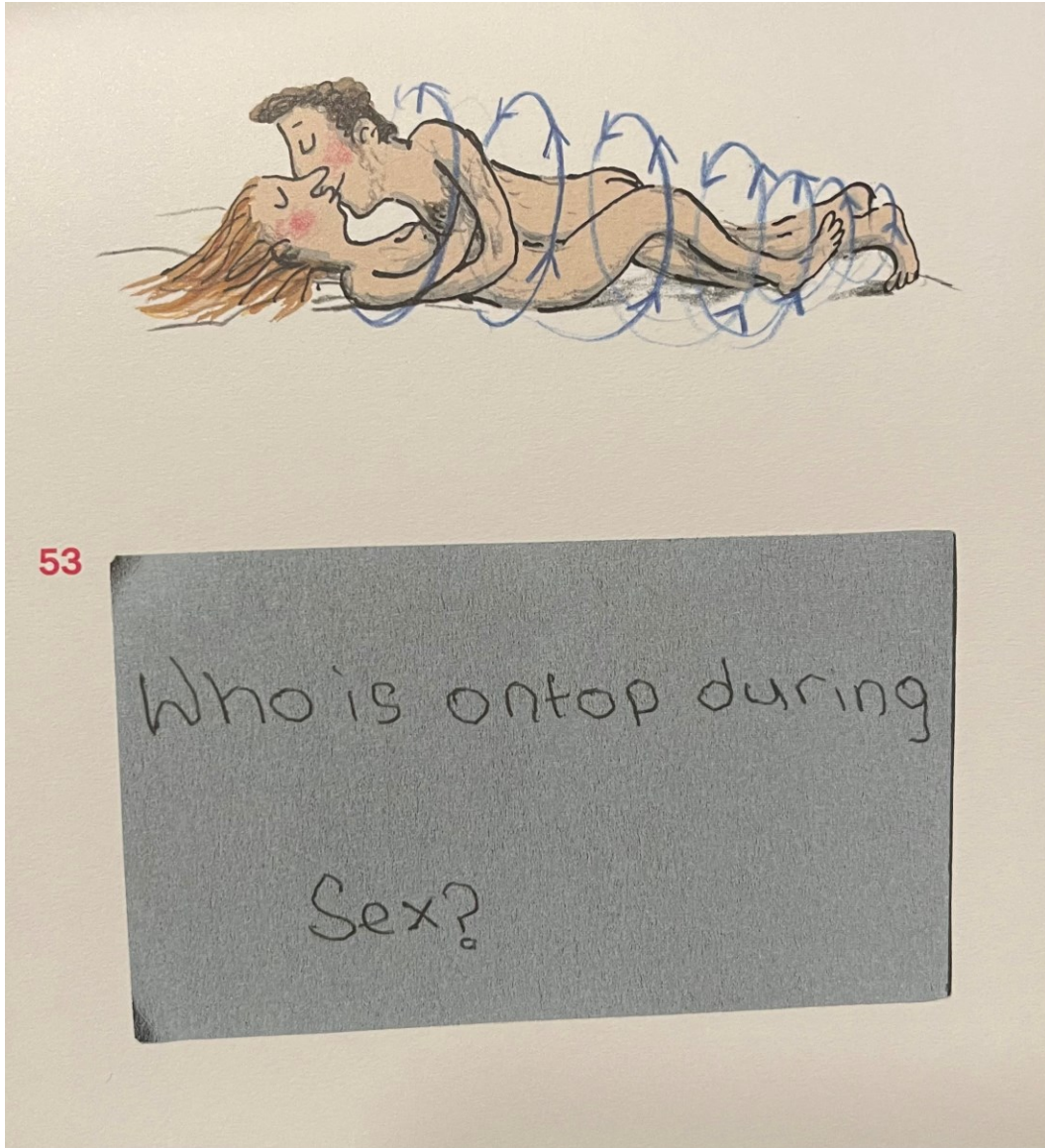
