


ANNE FRANK'S DIARY: THE GRAPHIC ADAPTATION

115	The illustration on this page depicts Anne standing next to a wall with an image projected onto it. A young man is looking at the image with dazed eyes. The image of a set of concentric ovals representing the many folds of a vulva.
124	The illustrations on the bottom of the page depict Anne kissing a young man.
127	Father's unhappy with me. After our talk on Sunday he thought I'd stop going upstairs every evening. He won't have any of that "necking" going on.
137	The illustration on the middle of the page depicts pregnant women standing behind woman lying back on the floor with their knees bent. Babies are crawling in front of the women on the floor. Young men and soldiers are running in front of the babies.
138	The illustration on the top-left side of the page depicts a woman standing in front of a soldier. The Nazi soldier has a gun to her head. The woman has her hand around his wrist saying, "KILL ME, YOU LAZY NAZI COWARD!" The illustration on the top-middle of the page depicts the same woman described by herself with a noose around her neck. She is saying, "PULL THE ROPE, YOU LAZY" The image on the top-right side of the page depicts the same woman alone with a knife to her chest. She is saying, "IF YOU CAN'T DO IT, I WILL!"
143	The illustrations on the middle of the page depict a series in which a soldier is walking toward another soldier. The walking soldier shoots his rifle at the other one's head. There are globs of blood coming out of the man's head. The next image depicts the man who shot, lying on the ground with a pool of blood around his head as the other soldier looks down at him. The illustration on the bottom of the page depicts several soldiers aiming rifles at other soldiers lying on the ground. See Figure 2.
