

	Note to Parents
	At some point in elementary school, probably around ages seven to ten, your child will want to have a more specific explanation of where babies come from.

	The illustration on the right of the page depicts a nude man in a frontal view with his genitals exposed.
	The text at the bottom of the page reads: Until you are an adult and ready to make such important decisions about being sexual with someone and about having babies, it is okay to appreciate and explore your own body. See Figure 2.

	Sometimes as you are growing up, especially when your body starts to really change, you may think about "sexy stuff" and wonder, is this okay? Not only is it okay, most kids do.






