

6	Gender can also refer to how people see themselves. This is called gender identity. Sometimes, this isn't the same as biological sex. If a person has a gender identity that's different from their sex at birth, they might call themselves transgenderPeople who don't feel either male or female might call themselves non-binary. Gender identity is what we feel we really are.
