

5	Slavery was rooted in white supremacy, the belief that white people are a superior race.
10	They could be beaten, whipped, sold away from their families, abused, and murdered.
	The group took control of a store, grabbed weapons, and killed the shopkeepers. Then they killed white homeowners and burned buildings.
	About two hundred Black people, many of whom were not involved in the rebellion, were murdered by white mobs.


