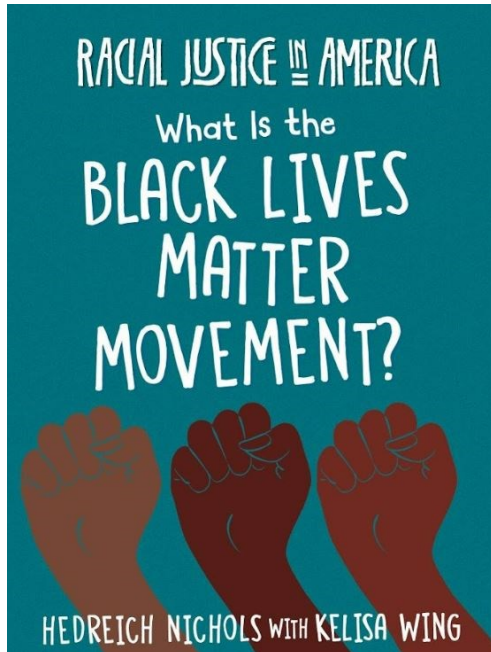

4	But unfairness and anti-Black racism are different. America's legal and educational systems make it harder for people in the Black community to get a good education, be successful, and build wealth.
5	Black people are also subject to racial profiling.
6	In 2014, another unarmed teenager, Michael Brown, was murdered by police in Ferguson, Missouri.
7	BLM supports communities in their fight against anti-black racism. It also supports efforts by other marginalized groups- women's rights, LGBTQ...rights, and immigrants' legal and human rights.
8	They could not inherit money from their fathers or pass money on to their children, which is how White families have been able to gain wealth across generations.
11	Lynching is a word that describes illegal mob killings of Black people. White people would forcibly take Black people and hang them from trees, burn them alive, or beat them until death or near death.
14	A number of high-profile killings of Black citizens in police custody and by White vigilantes showed that there was a renewed need for organized protests and anti-racist activism.
22	These groups, some with ties to White supremacist groups, started using hashtags like #AllLivesMatter and #BlueLivesMatter.
26	Becoming anti-racist requires actively working against racism using words and actions.
